
Minimum hourly wages to be paid to Apprentices:

05 thru 06 months.....60%	19 thru 24 months.....75%	37 thru 42 months.....90%
07 thru 12 months.....65%	25 thru 30 months.....80%	43 thru 48 months.....95%

All other Contributions and Dues Check offs will be paid to the CIC Health & Welfare Trust Fund,  
PO Box 19437, Springfield, IL, 62794.
