Effective May 1, 2025 thru April 30, 2026

the following wages and fringe benefits shall apply

Iron Worker Hourly Wage Rate	- \$39.24 per hour
Foreman	- Not less than \$1.90/hr. above scale (5/1/25-7/30/25)
	- Not less than \$2.75/hr. above scale (effective 8/1/25)
General Foreman (15 or more Iron Workers)	- Not less than \$3.00/hr. above scale (5/1/25-7/30/25)
	- Not less than \$4.00/hr. above scale (effective 8/1/25)
